Each year, MCOG seeks public input and citizen participation to identify unmet transit needs in our community. An unmet transit need is defined as a need to transport people that is not being satisfied through existing public or private resources.

NOTICE of PUBLIC HEARING Unmet Transit Needs

Monday, February 5, 2024, the Mendocino Council of Governments (MCOG) will meet at 1:30 p.m. or as soon thereafter as possible, in person and via teleconference with call-in options, at County Administration Center, Supervisors Chambers, Room 1070, 501 Low Gap Road, Ukiah; City Hall, 416 N. Franklin St., Fort Bragg; and City Hall, 451 School St., Point Arena, CA, and consider the following item.

MCOG will consider needs for public transportation services that would benefit a significant number of people and are not currently provided. This hearing applies to transportation service needs for fiscal year July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025. In addition to new public testimony, MCOG will hear needs reported to Mendocino Transit Authority during the past year, and findings of MCOG's Social Services Transportation Advisory Council. Issues may include but are not limited to: 1) transit services for the elderly, people with disabilities, and low-income or economically disadvantaged persons; 2) adequacy of both private and public transportation services, and 3) service improvements needed to meet expected travel demand.
