Testimony Heard in Public Hearing December 7, 2020 (not in any order of priority)

Needs Identified at the SSTAC workshop:

- 1. Non-emergency medical transportation for patients discharged from hospitals during transit service off-hours
- 2. Wednesday service for Ukiah Senior Center
- 3. Brooktrails fixed-route service
- 4. Willits weekday door-through-door service after 4pm and weekend service
- 5. Restoration of COVID-related temporary service cuts
- 6. Fixed-route service to Hopland
- 7. Fixed-route service to Potter Valley
- 8. Service to Covelo and Laytonville
- 9. Mobility solutions for remote communities.

Needs Identified by Mendocino Transit Authority (MTA):

- 1. Full service the day after Thanksgiving holiday
- 2. Additional Ukiah-Hopland round trip
- 3. Research on clean mobility grants for bikes and scooters
- 4. Resumption of Route 65 service
- 5. Round-trip service from Ukiah to South Coast and from Ukiah to Fort Bragg/Mendocino
